# **Irving Swimmers Spirit Wear & Equipment Orders**

Are you up to date on your Spirit Wear and equipment? All swimmers should have their own equipment according to Coach Tom and Coach Britt's request.

Spirit Wear, swim caps, etc. will be available throughout the year. We even have a few of the "Racing & Having Fun" hand towels that were given to the B/C meet participants in September. They're only \$2.50 each, just write it in on a blank line on the order form if you would like one or more.

John Sherwood is our Spirit Wear & Equipment chairperson. He is usually at the pool two or three days a week. Just ask your Coach to point him out if you've never met him. You can also leave a form with payment in the mailbox on the cage door at North Lake pool. If you have any questions about what your swimmer needs, please see their Coach.

# **USA Swimming Rules Changes**

USA Swimming just had it's annual convention here in Dallas in late September. There are a few items that were decided there that directly affect our team.

First, effective January 1, 2011, there will no longer be exhibition swims at any meet unless there was an administrative error on the part of the host team. Swimmers with one or two BB times cannot swim those events in a B/C meet as



exhibition. This works the same for swimmers with one or two A times, they cannot swim those events at a BB or B/C meet.

Second, as of January 1, all non-athlete members of USA Swimming must have a Criminal Background Check (CBC). This includes officials, team board members and all coaches. If you would like to serve on the IS Board of Directors, this will be a requirement. USAS has not chosen the company that will handle these and they have given no details beyond the fact that they will be required. CBC's from any other organization cannot be used. We'll let you know more when WE know more!

# **North Texas Swimming Rules Changes**

North Texas Swimming LSC (Local Swim Committee) is the regional governing body for our team. We are required to follow the policies and procedures put forth by the Committee as well as those of USA Swimming.

The NTS LSC House of Delegates meets four times per year to decide on open issues regarding the 26 teams that they govern. Each North Texas team, including Irving Swimmers, has delegates that are allowed to vote on issues brought by the committee. The last meeting was held in September of 2010.

At this last meeting, many issues in the NTS LSC Policies and Procedures were voted on and updated. There will be another special meeting in November to vote on additional items. There were quite a few items that directly effect our team as well as items that effect upcoming swim meets.

Please visit the <u>North Texas Swimming</u> website for more information. You may also view all the <u>proposed changes</u> to the Policies and Procedures (at the bottom of the website page) and voice your opinion to Anne Rice, one of our team's delegates, and she can bring up your concerns at the next House of Delegates meeting in November. I urge all our parents to take the time to look at what is happening in our LSC.

### **Team Outreach**

If you have or know of a swimmer that is eligible for the reduced/free lunch within your school district, he or she is also eligible to receive their USA Swimming registration for only \$5.00 instead of the

normal \$57. This information is not made public to the team or anyone else if a family chooses to take advantage of it. Please see your Coach or contact the IS team treasurer.
